After taking this class you should know your strengths, recognize your weaknesses and know what and how to practice.

We will be shooting at about 300 rounds of ammo.

The concepts of combat mindset, threat confrontation, and control of all visual areas while moving off the line of force combined with "GEAR EFFECT SHOOTING" will be emphasized throughout the class. Although this class is geared towards the semi-automatic pistol, revolvers are welcome.

- Review of shooting fundamentals;
- The natural action stance and thumbs forward grip (semi-automatic pistol only);
- Advanced methodology of shooting the semi-automatic pistol and revolver;
- Review of Presentation of the semi-automatic pistol and revolver from ready pistol;
- Review of Presentation of the semi-automatic pistol and revolver from the holster;
- Moving off the line of force;
- Threat assessment and area scanning;
- Ammunition management and reloading techniques;
- One hand shooting techniques;
- Shooting while moving----Why you **SHOULD** have an optic or laser on your carry gun.
- Securing the threat;
- Weapon retention issues;
- Disparity of force issues;
- Review of the use of the flash sight picture vs. perfect sight alignment;
- Review of front sight proximity and C.A.R. shooting;
- Use of barricades in defensive shooting;
- Shooting from kneeling positions.
- Simulated shooting from a vehicle.
